

Ready to get to work?

A quick guide to **Supported Internships** in Cornwall 2025-26

If you're a young person aged 16-24 with an Education, Health and Care plan, **a Supported Internship can help you get into work.**

You'll learn the skills you need for work, while spending most of your time in a real workplace. You can also study for qualifications, like English and Maths.

How does it work?

- **A Job Coach works with you and your employer throughout the Internship.**

They help you to work out tasks and learn new skills.

Will I be paid?

- **No. Supported Internships are classed as education.** The aim is to help you into paid work when your internship is finished.

How long will it last?

- **6 to 12 months.**

What kind of work can I do?

- **There's a range of Supported Internship available across Cornwall.** Industry-lead internships, where an organisation offers several different roles; or provider-lead internships, where a learning provider works with you to find a suitable placement.
